

NOMINATIONS AND ELECTION NOTICE

University of Detroit - Mercy Professors Union (UDMPU)

NOMINATIONS

Nominations for the offices of President, Vice-President, Secretary Treasurer, MEA representative and the following UDMPU Representatives will be accepted: Architecture - 1 position, Business Administration - 1 position, Liberal Arts and Education - 3 positions, Engineering & Science - 2 positions, Health Professions - 2 position, and Library - 1 position.

Verbal and written nominations will be accepted by the Nominations/Election Committee at anytime from 9:00 a.m. on February 22, 2010, through 12:00 Noon on March 25, 2010. Self-nominations are permitted; seconds are not required.

Nominations will also be accepted from the floor of the March 25, 2010, membership meeting scheduled for Engineering 237, 4001 McNichols, Detroit, Michigan. The meeting will begin at 12:45 p.m.; nominations will open at 1:00 p.m. Nominations can be verbal or written. Self-nominations are permitted; seconds are not required.

Candidates must accept nomination at the nomination meeting or, if not in attendance, provide a verbal or written acceptance to the Nominations/Election Committee by 12:00 p.m., March 25, 2010.

Any member in good standing both at the time of their nomination and as of the close of nominations on March 25, 2010, will be eligible to nominate candidates and run for office.

Although candidates may accept nomination for up to two positions, they can not concurrently serve in more than a single elected position. Candidates may accept nomination for up to two positions under the following conditions: one nomination must be for an officer (President, Vice-President, Secretary or Treasurer) and the other for that of a representative. Note however, if subsequently elected to both positions, s/he will assume the officer position and will automatically forfeit acceptance of the representative position. The candidate with the second highest vote in the vacated representative position will be considered the elected alternate and will automatically assume the seat vacated by the newly elected officer. If there is no elected alternate, and in the absence of a special election to fill the position, said position will remain vacant.

The Nominations/Election Committee is comprised of the following members:, Kris McLonis (Chair), Prasad Venugopal, and Joanne Yastik. Committee members can be contacted via their respective campus telephones and/or addresses available through a campus directory.

UDMPU members should ensure that their most recent home address is on file with the Nominations/Election Committee. Any recent changes should be submitted as soon as possible.
